Types of image editors

Built in tools

- . Settings on your phone and/or camera
- . Tools built into your phone (minus apps you add) – crop, filters, change focus
- . Tools embedded in social media – edit through Facebook, etc.
- . Apps – software that needs to be loaded on a phone or certain types of software (Windows apps) - Aviary
- . Image editors online (cloud) – software hosted at site – Adobe Creative*, Ribbet, Pixelr, others
- . Image editing software (standalone, you download) – examples GIMP
- . Lots of choices!

Basic photography tips: Setting the scene

Photography follows many art and design rules

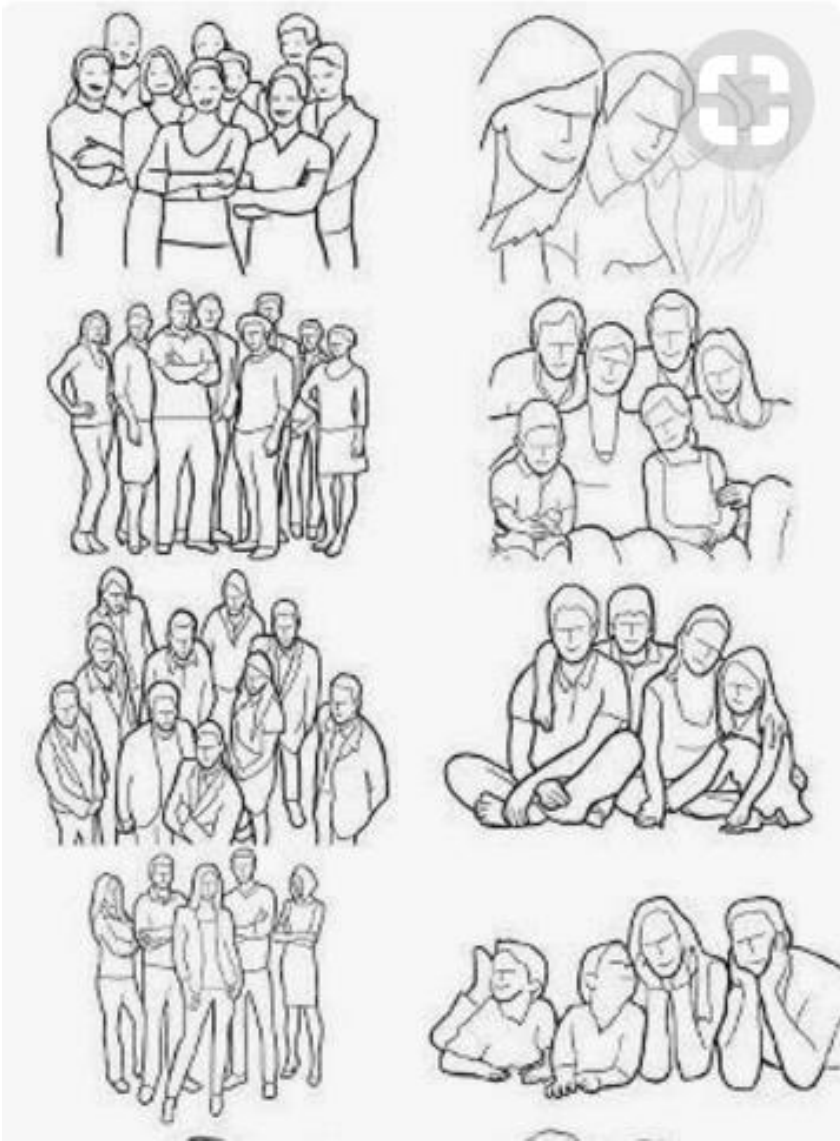
- Think about the arrangement of objects and/or people
- Generally, the closest item to the camera (viewer) will appear bigger
- Consider the background – do people have “horns” sticking out of their heads (e.g., tree branches?)
- Models know how to position their bodies to change how they appear – you can learn these tricks, too

Basic photography tips: Setting the scene

- “Soft” lighting (but not flat light) is the typically best for photographing people – this can mean using a fill flash to even out differences between people and the background, shooting in shade or on a semi-cloudy day
- Don’t have people face the sun
- Flat lighting is when there is little distinguishing contrast between objects and background – often characterized by a lack of shadows and highlights

Basic photography tips: Setting the scene

- Scope out/plan the photograph – review lighting and backgrounds prior to adding the subject
- Take practice shots without subjects
- If you are photographing people, plan wardrobes accordingly (are you photographing on green grass? Do you really want everyone wearing green?) People can be grouped in numerous ways – by height, by color of clothes, etc.



Positioning people (and yourself!)

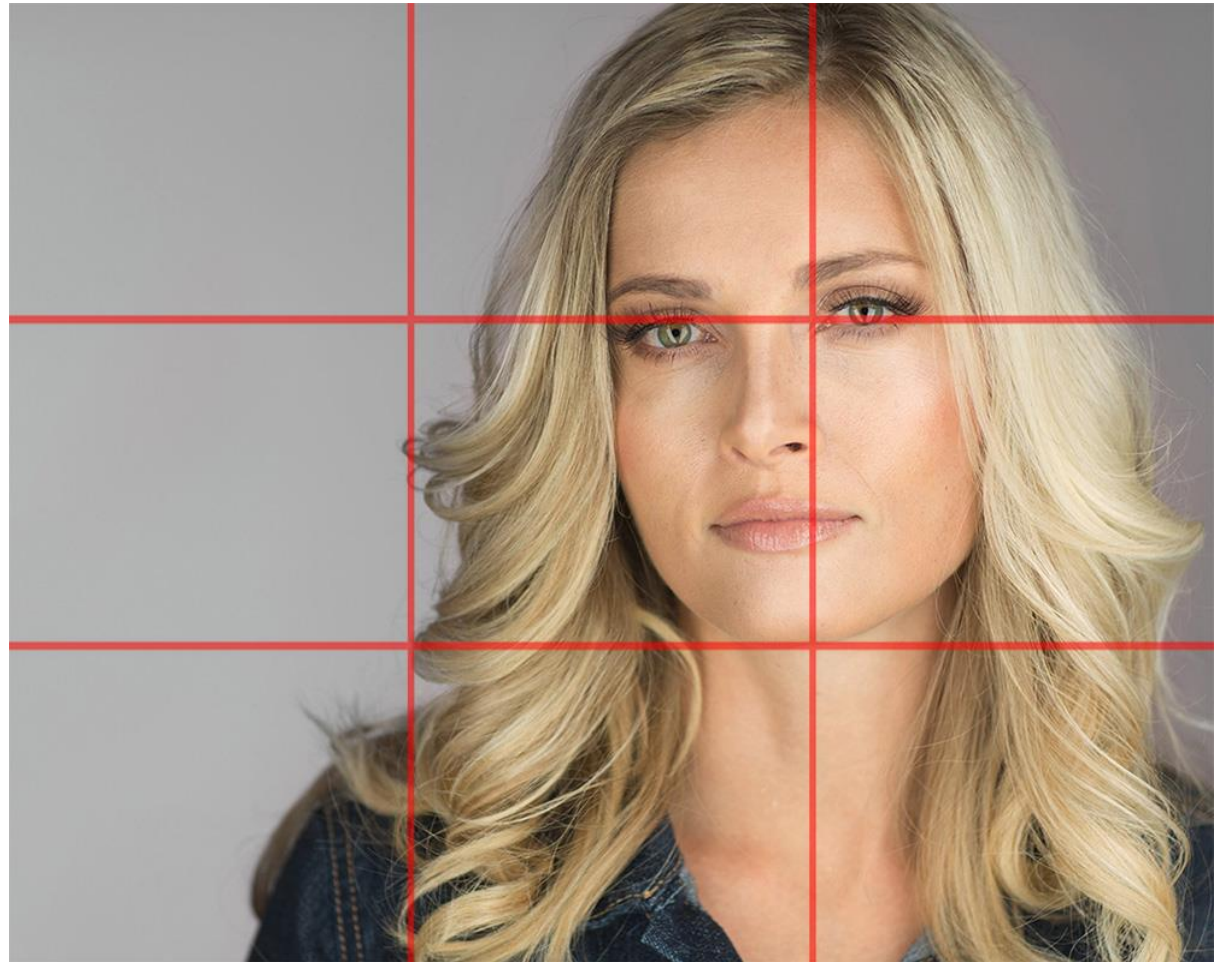
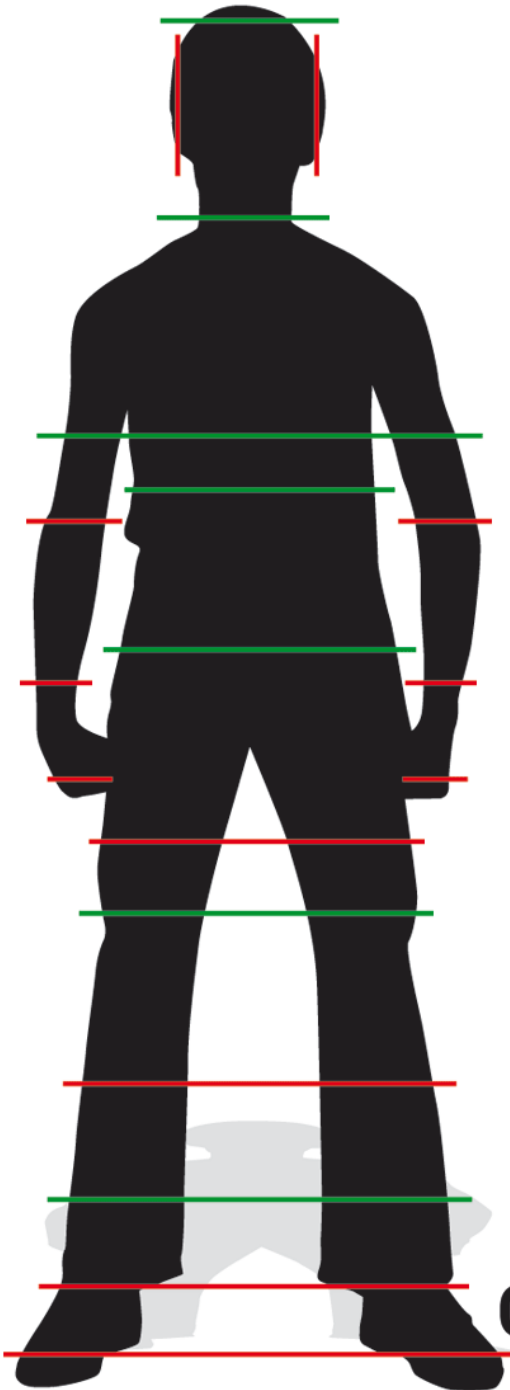
- “Skinny” arm on hip
- Create gaps between within the space of your body
- Make yourself appear smaller (turn from camera)
- Stick your chin out slightly
- Avoid direct sunlight photography
- Well fitting clothes & hair styling (tidy up clothes if needed)
- Emphasize the good



Basic photography tips: Setting the scene

- The background – is it distracting? Does it read right (e.g., either nonobtrusive or part of the story?)
- What is in the background – signs, trash, cars? Move your subject if needed.
- Change your angle – typically shooting slightly above a person is more flattering 😊
- Blur backgrounds
- Try several takes – no need to take “one and done”

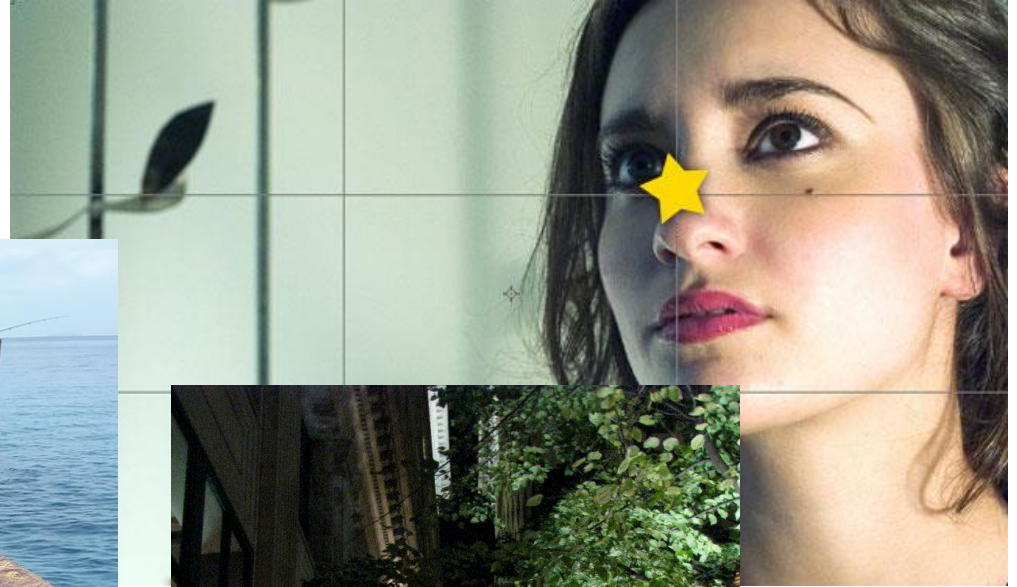

- Rotate canvas 180°
- Rotate canvas 90° CW

Cropping tools

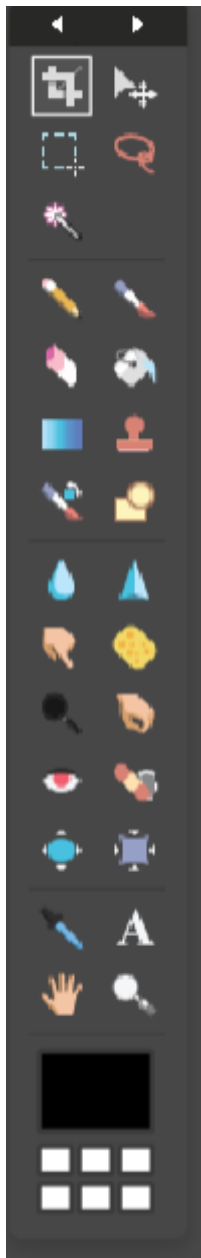


Adjustment

- Go to menu for correction
- Auto levels give it a try
- Don't forget CTRL+Z > Undo

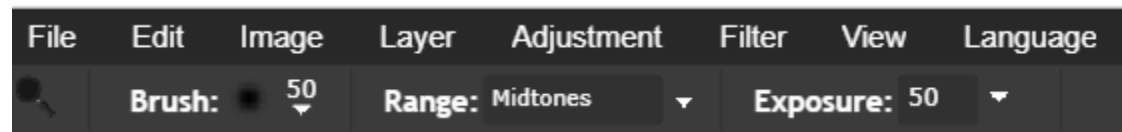
What to fix – over or under exposed

- Brightness and contrast — start with brightness
- Exposure
- Levels
- Curves can fix exposure or color but is a more advanced setting



Side menu has many tools for creating artwork (paint, etc.) and fixing images

- Crop
- Select (for selecting specific areas) useful for removing backgrounds
- Stamp (clone)
- Blur and heal – useful for portrait touchups (smooth skin, etc.)
- Red eye
- Dodge (Lighten), Burn (Darken)
- Control the intensity of effect with top menu

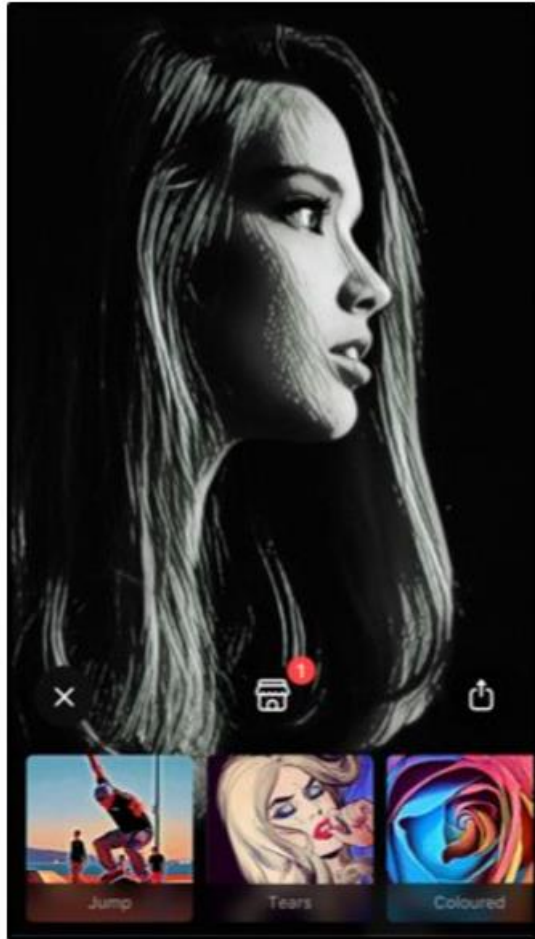
